



How to calculate your average GCSE Score

Each GCSE grade is given a number of points as outlined below:

9 = 9 points	4 = 5 points*
8 = 8 points	3 = 3 points
7 = 7 points	2 = 2 points
6 = 6 points	1 = 1 point
5 = 5 points	U = 0 points

*Grade 4 is valued at 5 points

Write down the GCSE subjects you have taken and the results you have achieved or hope to get. Then, add the points together and divide by the number of subjects you have taken.

Example

Grades achieved:

English = 6	Art and Design = 7
Maths = 5	Geography = 4 (worth 5 points)
History = 6	Drama = 3

Total = 32 points

Divided by number of subjects (6) = 5.3 average GCSE score
